Campus Planter

Hours: Full-Time

Church: Holy Cross is the cathedral church for the Anglican Diocese of the South. Our diocese currently has 11 active church plants and 6 more in the works. This network of planting provides significant opportunities for growth and coaching from experienced leaders, and it includes a wonderful group of planters to support each other in the work. Holy Cross is also Archbishop Foley Beach's home church. We are passionate about worship, sharing the gospel in our local context, and building meaningful community within the church. Prior to the onset of the COVID pandemic, we averaged 325 people per Sunday. During 2021, even with the challenges of the pandemic and changing in-person attendance, we welcomed over 50 new members to Holy Cross.

Position Description: The campus planter will be in residency for 18-24 months in order gain experience in a variety of church ministries, learn our DNA, and form a team to plant a new congregation. The planter will work significantly in the local community, making connections, sharing the gospel, leading teams to do ministry to those who are "near to us but far from Jesus." Through this process, the Campus Planter will help identify where God is calling us to plant a new campus and would serve as the planter/pastor of the new campus.

Personal Qualifications: The Campus Planter will have a deep trust in God, godly character, and a contagious faith. His life will be marked by:

- An ever-growing relationship with Jesus Christ
- The biblical characteristics of a priest/presbyter/elder (1 Timothy 3; Titus 1)
- Personal mission and evangelism to the lost (2 Timothy 4:5)
- Faithful prayer (Luke 10:2)
- Humble leadership (Philippians 2:3; Colossians 2:12)

Education and Work-Related Experience

- M.Div. or other appropriate theological training required
- Must demonstrate successful prior pastoral ministry (as lay or clergy)

Compensation: This is a full-time clergy position. Compensation will be commensurate with experience and will include salary and benefits. Salary range available upon request. A portion of the compensation package (approximately \$10,000/year) will need to be fundraised by the Campus Planter. (The skills needed to cast vision and obtain supporters are necessary in this form of ministry, so being able to fundraise some from the beginning will be part of the job.)

Anglicanism: N. T. Wright, C. S. Lewis, J. I. Packer, John Stott, Janani Luwum just to name a few influential leaders in the Christian Church who were part of our Anglican tradition. We're members of the worldwide Anglican Communion, made up of over 75 million Christians in this tradition. We're Bible-believing, evangelical Christians who value the traditions handed down to us throughout the history of the Church. Anglicanism is by no means the only way to be a Christian, but it is a reliable way that has stood the test of time and helped change the world and spread the Gospel.
