Hours: Part-Time Contract Role (12-14 hours weekly)

About Holy Cross Cathedral: Holy Cross Cathedral is the cathedral parish of the Anglican Diocese of the South, part of the Anglican Church in North America. We are a welcoming and vibrant community committed to leading people into a growing relationship with Jesus Christ through worship, discipleship, and service. Our mission is rooted in the historic Christian faith, expressed in the beauty of Anglican tradition, and lived out in love for our neighbors and the world God has called us to reach.

Position Description: The Organist provides musical accompaniment for the traditional service (currently at 9:00 AM) and other special off-Sunday services. This position requires the Organist to use their musical gifts to advance the ministry of the Cathedral through creative and worshipful music. This position reports to the Choir Director and the Rector/Dean of the Cathedral.

Essential Responsibilities:

- Play all Sundays for the traditional service of the Church and other off-Sunday liturgical services (Ash Wednesday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Christmas Eve, Evensong, and such).
- In addition to accompaniments, play preludes, postludes, and other necessary music.
- Participate in rehearsals, as directed by the Choir Director.
- Be available to play for weddings and funerals, as convenient. First refusal, of course, belongs to the Cathedral Organist.
- Provide organ music for diocesan ordination services (as needed), compensated by the Diocese, also for Synod worship (usually on a Friday in November).
- Lead the rehearsal when the Choir Director is absent.

Professional Requirements: The Organist will have:
Musical excellence; keyboard competence; pastoral flexibility with parish choir.

Compensation: This is a part-time contracted position, 12-14 hours per week. Compensation shall be \$345 for Sunday services, \$200 for rehearsals, and \$345 for special services (Christmas Eve, diocesan convention, and other services as needed). Compensation for weddings and funerals will be \$200.
